Dear Patients,

InfusionCare has been honored to provide infusion and injection services in Latham to our patients, and we know how important these treatments are to your ongoing health.

Due to the departure of our supervising physician, Dr. Jessica Chapman, who will be leaving CCP to practice at Hudson Headwaters, InfusionCare will be closing effective February 1, 2026. Dr. Chapman is our only full-time rheumatologist overseeing the practice, and without her, we are unable to continue operations.

We understand that this news may come as a surprise and may raise concerns. Our main priority is to ensure you remain on schedule with your infusions/injections. We have taken steps to transition your care to a nearby CCP practice that is fully prepared to continue your treatment without interruption:

Upstate Hematology Oncology (UHO)

Approximately 20+ medications will continue to be offered at UHO; the only medications not offered at UHO are Potassium, Remicade, Octogam/Gammagard, representing a small minority of patients. If you are receiving those medications from InfusionCare, please see the below locations where you are able to continue treatment.

What to do next:

- 1. First, please call our office at 518-782-3899 to let us know where you have decided to continue your infusions.
- 2. Next, if you selected to receive care at UHO, to remain on schedule with your treatment, please call UHO at (518) 836-3030 before January 31, 2025, to schedule your next infusion—even if it is more than six months away. This step is important to help prevent any delays in your care. UHO is part of CCP and uses the same electronic health record system, so they already have access to your complete medical record. There is no need to transfer records.
 - We understand that building a strong relationship takes time and trust, but we want to assure you the specialists at UHO will provide you with the same quality care to which you are accustomed. Due to limited infusion resources in our community, we strongly recommend transitioning to UHO to avoid missing treatments.
- 3. If you are unable or unwilling to continue care at UHO, you will need to contact the provider who is managing your condition and referred you to InfusionCare. They will need to submit a new referral order to an infusion provider outside of CCP, such as Albany Med InfusionCenter in Albany (43 New Scotland Ave, A248 Phone # for appointments 518-262-3545; Referral Fax 518-262-3532; valet parking at Physician Pavillion), Capital District Advanced Infusions in Latham (1182 Troy-Schenectady Road), or KabaFusion in Albany (12 Jupiter Lane).

We truly understand our patients' disappointment with this change. Our team is here to make this transition as easy as possible for you and your referral provider, who we have also notified of this change. We appreciate your understanding.
